COVID-19 Mitigation Plan

1. Classes will be limited in size in accordance with the current phase.
2. Students and instructors will maintain a 6' distance during class.
3. 6' spacing will be maintained in the lobby—up to 2 persons at a time.
4. Back-to-back classes will be scheduled with sufficient time between classes to sanitize as per mandate. Traffic flow has been carefully designed so that groups do not share space as they arrive/depart.
5. Instructor, owner or other employee will clean and disinfect all common-touch surfaces (door knobs, light switches, toilet flusher, water faucet knobs, equipment, ballet barres, sound system, etc.)
6. Staff will be trained in proper disinfecting guidelines, as recommended by the CDC.
7. Thorough cleaning of facility will occur weekly.
8. No staff may come to work if they are currently exhibiting COVID symptoms.
9. No staff may come to work if they have had a fever within the the past 72 hours.
10. All students/parents will be asked to sign the Parent/Student Questionnaire Form prior to first class.
11. Drop Off/Pick Up Protocol: Students and parents/siblings/legal guardians/nannies are asked NOT to congregate in the lobby or stay during classes. To drop off: One at a time, the responsible adult will drop-off or bring child to the front door. The teacher will lead the student into the lobby, at which time there may be a temperature check (forehead). Parents/caregivers do not leave until the child has been cleared. To pick up: One parent at a time will come to outside of the front door to make contact with the teacher/parent monitor in the lobby. Then, that child will be allowed to leave the studio, go through the lobby, and depart with his/her parent/designee, (or if older student, walk to the parent's car). We have instated a safe plan to keep two crossing groups separated while entering/exiting the studio. Incoming students will go to specific marks on the dance floor. Exiting students will wait on marked personal spots along the perimeter of the studio until their parent is visible outside the door.
