

Covid 19 Travelers Mandate
Updated February 25, 2021
(Subject to Change)

When parents sign the Eagle River Ballet Parent/Student Questionnaire, you are asked if your child has traveled out of state within the past 14 days. You must INFORM us of that travel and follow our current travel mandate before returning to class. You will not need to fill out a new Questionnaire.

The recent State of Alaska Travelers policy is not safe enough for our program. We will NOT be in sync with the Travelers Mandate found at alaska.gov until further notice.

After arriving in Alaska from out of state, all students, regardless of age, MUST be tested for SARS-CoV2, with a molecular-based (PCR) test. This test may be taken within 72 hours of arrival to Alaska, at the airport upon arrival, or as soon as possible. Your child must follow STRICT social distancing protocols (no school, no grocery stores, no ballet) until the he/she receives a negative test result.

In addition, we require 5 total days, with your arrival day being day #1, of STRICT social distancing, during which time your child must be symptom-free before returning to class.

Upon returning to Alaska, parents must EMAIL the following information regarding your child's travel to the director. You are responsible for computing your return date to class.

- Your child has traveled out of state within the last 14 days
- The date your child returned to Alaska
- If tested, provide the date your child was tested
- If tested, inform us of your child's negative test result
- You agree to the 5 days of strict social distancing before returning to class.
- If you choose not to test, you will observe strict social distancing for 10 days.

For all other variables, including, but not limited to: possible exposure to a positive individual, definite exposure to a positive individual, or a positive test result for your child or a family household member, please follow recommendations by a Municipality or State Healthcare Provider (ie, Public Health Nurse, Contact Tracer, Pediatrician or Family Physician, etc.).
